1. How much will this test /surgery/exam cost?
2. How will this test/surgery/exam change my treatment?
3. Which blood test are you ordering? What X-ray? Why?
4. Are there cheaper alternatives that are equally good?
5. Where will this test/surgery/exam be performed - hospital, surg center, office — impact on price?
6. Who else will be involved in my treatment? Separate bill from other providers? In my insurance network?

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Next Time in a Hospital Use these Precautions

1. Avoid a private room.
2. Avoid out-of-network charges. - “as long as the providers are in my insurance network.”
3. Be clear on the terms of your stay in the hospital - observation status”
4. Identify every unfamiliar person who appears at your bedside. – write it all down
5. Refuse unnecessary equipment
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
